

March of the Living General Rules for 2017

- 1. Consumption of alcoholic beverages on the March of the Living program is prohibited at all times.
- 2. There is a zero-tolerance policy for the use of drugs on the March of the Living program. The use of recreational drugs and the abuse of prescription medications are strictly prohibited.
- 3. Participants must respect their fellow peers and may not engage in any unwanted physical contact at any time or place.
- 4. The March of the Living is an educational program which teaches and enforces Jewish value and is not the appropriate environment for any kind of sexual activity / relationships.
- 5. Participation in gambling and/or entrance to casinos is strictly prohibited.
- 6. A midnight curfew will be enforced. At this time, participants are required to exit the common areas in hotel lobbies and gathering areas and to enter their designated rooms.
- 7. Participants are forbidden from leaving the group or hotel without adult supervision unless given explicit permission from a group leader.
- 8. Students are expected to respect their peers as well as listen and adhere to the rules communicated by their madrichim, group leaders and MOTL staff.

The March from Auschwitz to Birkenau

The code of behavior during the March from Auschwitz to Birkenau is as follows:

- Participants are expected to march in a respectful manner.
- The March is a silent March. Singing and any other kind of loud, boisterous behavior is contrary to the spirit of the March and is discouraged.
- Students are expected to march in order with their delegations.
- Flags and other similar paraphernalia from students' countries, schools and organizations are not to be displayed during the March of the Living from Auschwitz to Birkenau. Only signs of the March of the Living, those provided by the March of the Living and Israeli flags will be permitted.
